Her body of work is defined by a sophisticated interplay of art and design, firmly rooted in conceptual and textual foundations that underpin the intricate physical and technical processes involved in crafting her pieces. Her creations capture arresting imagery of the distorted body, intertwined with meticulous textile research, resulting in sculptural masterpieces. Her artistic vision is propelled by a profound admiration for the inherent beauty of simple geometric shapes and a creative intuition that explores the potential they offer. Her projects aim to dismantle the dichotomy between subjects and objects, challenging fixed aspects. Through her work, she prompts viewers to reevaluate their relationships with a society teetering on the edge of collapse. By cultivating self-awareness and embracing self-denial, she forges connections that enable positive responses—an attitude that defies power dynamics that erode or hierarchize vulnerability. Observers will sense diverse sensibilities within themselves as they engage with her work. In this enclosed space, the audience will encounter the prospect of solidarity and collaboration that gives rise to novel forms and alternative existence. Her unwavering commitment to inclusivity, sustainability, and interdependence shines through her innovative approach to repurposing materials, serving as a potent expression of her dedication to sustainable design and art.


